HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:

Taxation Rate Cap for Class 2 Property Regulation

- 1 Section 2 (a) of the Taxation Rate Cap for Class 2 Property Regulation, B.C. Reg. 329/96, is amended by striking out "\$40" and substituting "\$44.615".
