## **Application**

This regulation applies in respect of proceedings before the Provincial Court under the *Family Law Act* in which an order for guardianship, parenting arrangements, contact or support is sought or in which variation of such an order is sought.

# Directions to attend parenting programs

- 2 (1) The Chief Judge of the Provincial Court may give directions requiring parties in proceedings to attend parenting programs operated by the Ministry of Attorney General.
  - (2) The Chief Judge may designate registries of the Provincial Court to which a direction under subsection (1) applies.
