



CHAPTER 51.

An Act to amend the "Municipal
Superannuation Act."

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia,
enacts as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Municipal Superannuation Act Amendment Act, 1946." Short title

2. Section 12 of the "Municipal Superannuation Act," being chapter 57 of the Statutes of 1938 as amended by section 15 of chapter 49 of the Statutes of 1940, is further amended by adding the following as subsection (3):— Amends s. 12

"(3.) If any employee to whom this Act applies is paid an annual salary in ten equal instalments, on the basis of at least ten months' employment in every year, the number of years of service of such employee shall be calculated on the basis of twelve months in every year during which he was so employed."

3. Section 13 is amended by inserting after "policeman" in the first line of clause (a) of subsection (1), and also after "policeman" in the first line of clause (b) of subsection (1), the words "and drivers of public passenger-vehicles other than tramway vehicles." Amends s. 13

4. Section 14 is amended by inserting after "policeman" in the first line of clause (b), and also after "policeman" in the first line of clause (c), in each case the words "and drivers of public passenger-vehicles other than tramway vehicles." Amends s. 14
