



CHAPTER 33.

1955, c. 57.

An Act to amend the "Municipalities Aid Act."

[Assented to 2nd March, 1956.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Municipalities Aid Act, 1955, Amendment Act, 1956."

Amends s. 3.

2. Section 3 of the "Municipalities Aid Act," being chapter 53 of the Statutes of 1955, is amended by striking out subsection (1), and substituting the following:—

"(1) At such times and in such manner as the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may prescribe, the Minister of Finance shall, in each year, pay from the Consolidated Revenue Fund to each municipality, whether incorporated before or after the coming into force of this Act, as a local government grant, an amount computed as follows:—

- "(a) The sum of sixteen dollars in respect of each person in the population of the municipality up to three thousand five hundred persons:
- "(b) The sum of twelve dollars in respect of each person in the population of the municipality in excess of three thousand five hundred and up to eight thousand persons:
- "(c) The sum of eight dollars in respect of each person in the population of the municipality in excess of eight thousand and up to fifty thousand persons:
- "(d) The sum of six dollars and fifty cents in respect of each person in the population in excess of fifty thousand persons."
