



CHAPTER 33.

An Act to amend the "Coal Mines Regulation Act." R. S., 1897, c. 138.

[12th March, 1909.]

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Coal Mines Regulation Act Short title. Amendment Act, 1909."

2. Rule 23 of section 82 of the "Coal Mines Regulation Act," being Amends s. 82, Rule 23. chapter 138 of the Revised Statutes, 1897, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:—

"If in any mine the winding apparatus is not provided with some Winding apparatus. Speed cages are to be raised. automatic contrivance to prevent overwinding, then the cage, when men are being raised, shall not be wound up at a speed exceeding three miles an hour, after the cage has reached a point in the shaft to be fixed by the special rules."

3. Rule 24 of said section 82 is hereby amended by adding thereto Amends s. 82, Rule 24. the following:—

"There shall be attached to every cage when used for lowering and Lowering cages to be provided with safety-clutch. raising persons in any shaft a proper and adequate automatic safety-clutch, which will effectually prevent the falling of any cage upon the breaking of the rope or the failure of the brake to operate."

4. This Act shall come into force upon the 1st day of May, Commencement. 1910.
