



CHAPTER 13.

An Act to amend the "Constitution Act."

R. S. B. C., c. 47.

[22nd April, 1902.]

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Constitution Act Amendment Short title. Act, 1902."

2. Section 20 of Chapter 47 of the Revised Statutes, 1897, as Re-enacts s. 20. enacted by section 2 of Chapter 38 of the Statutes of 1898, is hereby repealed, and the following section is substituted therefor:—

"20. The Legislative Assembly of British Columbia shall consist of forty-two members, to be elected in the manner provided by the "Provincial Elections Act," and to represent the Electoral Districts constituted and defined by and in the "Redistribution Act, 1902."

3. This Act shall come into force on the dissolution of the present Legislative Assembly. Commencement.
