

## CHAPTER 18

## An Act to Amend the Creditors' Relief Act

R.S.B.C. 1960,  
c. 85; O. in C.  
No. 779/61.

[Assented to 29th March, 1962.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

Title.           1. This Act may be cited as the *Creditors' Relief Act Amendment Act, 1962.*

Amends s. 6.    2. Section 6 of the *Creditors' Relief Act*, being chapter 85 of the *Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1960*, is amended by striking out subsections (6) and (7) and substituting:—

“(6) The District Registrar with whom the affidavit is to be filed shall be the District Registrar of the Supreme Court, as shown below, having regard to the Sheriff who gives the notice provided for by section 4:—

“(7) The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may from time to time, by regulation, alter the provisions of this section by providing for the filing of the affidavit with a District Registrar or District Registrars at a place or places different from the place mentioned in this section.”
