**An Act to amend the "Tourist Accommodation
Regulation Act."**

[Assented to 2nd March, 1956.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the "Tourist Accommodation Regulation Act Amendment Act, 1956."

Amends s. 2

2. Section 2 of the "Tourist Accommodation Regulation Act," being chapter 338 of the "Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1948," as amended by chapter 83 of the Statutes of 1951, is amended by striking out the definition of "rental unit," and substituting the following:—

"'Rental unit' includes house, cabin, cottage, kitchen, office, administration building, apartment, room, lodge, hut, tent, and other structure, or any part of any of them, maintained for the use of the public at tourist accommodation."

Amends s. 3

3. Section 3 is amended by striking out clauses (a) to (n), inclusive, of subsection (2), and by relettering clauses (o), (p), (q), and (r) as clauses (a), (b), (c), and (d) respectively.

Further amends s. 3

4. Section 3 is further amended by adding the following to subsection (2) as clause (e):—

"(e) Prescribing as the penalty for the breach of any regulation a fine of not more than one hundred dollars."

Amends s. 4

5. Section 4 is amended by renumbering subsection (2) as subsection (3), and by inserting the following as subsection (2):—

"(2) No person shall display, publish, or use any sign, symbol, or advertisement which indicates, or is calculated to indicate, that any

tourist accommodation has been classified under this Act or certified under the regulations unless in fact the tourist accommodation has been so classified or certified."
