

## CHAPTER 8

## British Columbia Railway Act

[Assented to 30th March, 1972.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

Change of  
name.

1. The name of the Pacific Great Eastern Railway Company, incorporated by and under the *Pacific Great Eastern Incorporation Act*, being chapter 36 of the Statutes of British Columbia, 1912 (hereinafter referred to as the “company”), is amended so that the name of the company is British Columbia Railway Company.

2. All the provisions of the *Pacific Great Eastern Incorporation Act* and any other Act respecting the company apply to the British Columbia Railway Company and nothing in this Act affects the rights and liabilities or any debt, duty, obligation, undertaking, privilege, credit, asset, property, chose in action, cause of action, or interest of the company.

3. Where in any Act, Order in Council, regulation, order, contract, certificate, licence, or other document made before the coming into force of this Act, a reference is made to the company, or to a director or officer of the company by any designation including the name of the company, the reference shall be deemed to be to the British Columbia Railway Company or to a director or officer thereof.
