



CHAPTER 89.

An Act respecting the Methodist Church.

[4th March, 1914.]

WHEREAS a petition has been presented by the Methodist Church praying that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Preamble.

Therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

1. Section 3 of chapter 20 in the “Statutes of British Columbia, 1884,” is hereby amended as follows:— 1884, c. 20. s. 3.
amended.

(a.) By striking out the word “first” in the last line of said section, and inserting after the word “Schedule,” in the said section, the letter “B.”

(b.) By adding thereto the following subsections:—

“(2.) All property, real or personal, held by trustees under the provisions of Schedule ‘B’ of said Act of incorporation shall hereafter be held by the said trustees upon the trusts set out in said Schedule as amended by any Act passed by the Parliament of Canada; and the said trustees shall be entitled to exercise all the rights and powers conferred upon trustees by the said Schedule as so amended. Trusts.”

“(3.) The Methodist Church and every Board established in accordance with the provisions of the said Act of incorporation, or any Act in amendment thereof, and all trustees or other persons appointed to administer the business of said Boards under the provisions of said Act of incorporation, or any Act in amendment thereof, shall have and may exercise within the Province all rights, powers, and privileges conferred, or intended to be conferred, upon it or them by said Act of incorporation, or any Act in amendment thereof passed by the Parliament of Canada.” Powers.

Short title.

2. This Act may be cited as the “Methodist Church Amending Act, 1914.”
