



## CHAPTER 52.

1908, c. 38.

**An Act to amend the “New Westminster Parks Act, 1908.”***[Assented to 27th March, 1953.]*

Preamble.

**W**HEREAS the Corporation of the City of New Westminster has represented that it is the desire of the Municipal Council and the electors of such city that it be permitted to use a portion of Tipperary Square for civic purposes:

And whereas it is desirable that such use should be permitted:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

Short title.

**1.** This Act may be cited as the “New Westminster Parks Act, 1908, Amendment Act, 1953.”

Amends s. 2.

**2.** Section 2 of the “New Westminster Parks Act, 1908,” being chapter 38 of the Statutes of 1908, is amended by striking out the words “school purposes, and until so used, and as to any part not so used, to maintain and use it for the recreation and enjoyment of the public as a public park” in the seventh, eighth, and ninth lines, and substituting “civic purposes, upon the condition that the school building now situate thereon may continue to be used for so long as is considered necessary as a public school, together with such area of Tipperary Square as may be agreed upon between the Municipal Council of the Corporation and the Board of School Trustees of School District No. 40 (New Westminster) as playing-fields for the public school.”
