



## CHAPTER 108.

### An Act relating to the Victoria Civic Arena.

[Assented to 20th March, 1959.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Victoria has by its petition represented that it is necessary and expedient in the interests of the inhabitants and ratepayers of the City of Victoria and of adjacent municipalities to enact the provisions hereinafter contained, and has prayed that the same may be enacted accordingly:

And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Victoria Civic Arena Act Amendment Act, 1959*.

Amends s. 3.

2. Section 3 of the *Victoria Civic Arena Act*, being chapter 75 of the Statutes of British Columbia, 1945, is hereby amended by deleting clause (a) thereof and substituting therefor the following clauses (a), (aa), and (aaa):—

“(a) To establish a Board of Commissioners consisting of five members who shall be appointed by the Council and, if the Council shall so determine by by-law, two ex officio members who shall be the Municipal Manager and the City Engineer for the time being of the City, but neither the said Municipal Manager nor the City Engineer shall vote on any question before the Board:

“(aa) No person not being an ex officio member as aforesaid shall be appointed to or hold office as a member of the said Board unless he shall be either (i) an owner-elect of the City of Victoria or (ii) a resident of the City of Victoria or of any of the municipalities of the District of Oak Bay, the District

of Saanich, or the Township of Esquimalt and as well either a person who is entitled to have his name entered upon the list of electors of the said city or a person who in a written authorization filed pursuant to section 31 of the *Municipal Act* is named as the agent of a corporation entitled to have its name entered on such list:

“(aaa) Not more than two of the members of the said Board shall be members of the Council.”
