



CHAPTER 88.

An Act to amend the "Dominion Trust Company Act, 1913, c. 89. 1913."

[4th March, 1914.]

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

1. Section 4 of the "Dominion Trust Company Act, 1913," is hereby amended by inserting the words "either alone or jointly with any other person or persons" after the words "or to any office" in the eighteenth line thereof, and by inserting the words "either alone or jointly with any other person or persons" after the word "trust" in the twenty-first line thereof. Amends s. 4.

2. Section 8 of said Act is hereby amended by inserting the words "either alone or jointly with any other person or persons" after the word "lunatic" in the fifth line thereof. Amends s. 8.

3. Sections 17 and 18 of the said Act are hereby repealed. Repeals ss. 17 and 18.

4. Section 26 of the said Act is hereby amended by striking out the words "so far as the same relate to the carrying-on by the said Company of any business within the Province" in the fourth and fifth lines of said section. Amends s. 26.

5. This Act may be cited as the "Dominion Trust Company Act, 1913, Amendment Act, 1914." Short title.
