



## CHAPTER 60.

An Act to amend the “Midway and Vernon Railway  
Company Act, 1901.”

[12th March, 1906.]

**W**HEREAS, a petition has been presented by the Midway and Vernon Railway Company for an Act to amend the “Midway and Vernon Railway Company Act, 1901,” by giving to the said Company power to build a railway from Vernon, in the Province of British Columbia, to Kamloops, in the said Province, and also to build a branch line from some point on the main line of the Company’s railway to Penticton, in the said Province, and to extend the time for completing the Company’s line of railway, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of this petition :

Therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows :—

**1.** Notwithstanding anything contained in the “British Columbia Railway Act,” or the Act of Incorporation of the Midway and Vernon Railway Company, the time for completion of the Company’s line of railway, and of the branches which the Company is authorised to build, is hereby extended until the 31st December, 1910, and the corporate existence and powers of the Company shall continue in any event in so far as regards any part of the Company’s line of railway which may be built by the said date.

Extension of time  
for completion.

**2.** The Midway and Vernon Railway Company may build, construct, maintain and operate a branch line of railway from any point on its main line to Penticton, in the Province of British Columbia.

Branch to Penticton.

Extension, Vernon  
to Ducks.

**3.** The Midway and Vernon Railway Company may build, construct, maintain and operate a line of railway from Vernon, in the Province of British Columbia, thence by way of the Salmon River and the Ducks, in the said Province, to the City of Kamloops, in the said Province.

Confirmation of  
rights, etc.

**4.** The Midway and Vernon Railway Company is hereby declared to be, and to have been since the 11th May, 1901, a body corporate and politic under the name of "The Midway and Vernon Railway Company," with all the rights, powers and privileges granted and conferred by the Company's Act of Incorporation, viz., the "Midway and Vernon Railway Company Act, 1901," as amended by section 3, sub-section (1), and section 4 of the "Midway and Vernon Railway Aid Act, 1902," and the Midway and Vernon Railway Company Act, 1901, Amendment Act, 1904."

Short title.

**5.** This Act may be cited as the "Midway and Vernon Railway Company Act, 1901, Amendment Act, 1906."
