

**CHAPTER 75.****An Act to amend the North-west Telephone
Company's Act, 1929.**

[Assented to 18th March, 1960.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS a petition has been presented by the North-west Telephone Company praying that the *North-west Telephone Company's Act, 1929*, be amended:

And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition:

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *North-west Telephone Company's Act Amendment Act, 1960*.

Amends s. 14.

2. Section 14 of the *North-west Telephone Company's Act, 1929*, being chapter 72 of the Statutes of British Columbia, 1929, is amended by inserting after the word "Province" in the third line thereof the words "or of Canada."

Commence-
ment.

3. This Act shall come into force on such date as may be fixed by the Lieutenant-Governor by his Proclamation.
