

## CHAPTER 75.

## An Act to amend the North-west Telephone Company's Act, 1929.

[Assented to 18th March, 1960.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS a petition has been presented by the North-west Telephone Company praying that the North-west Telephone Company's Act, 1929, be amended:

And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the North-west Telephone Company's Act Amendment Act, 1960.

Amends s. 14.

2. Section 14 of the North-west Telephone Company's Act, 1929, being chapter 72 of the Statutes of British Columbia, 1929, is amended by inserting after the word "Province" in the third line thereof the words "or of Canada."

Commencement. 3. This Act shall come into force on such date as may be fixed by the Lieutenant-Governor by his Proclamation.
