



CHAPTER 67.

An Act to amend the “Shaughnessy Heights
Building Restriction Act, 1922.”

[Assented to 30th November, 1939.]

WHEREAS by the “Shaughnessy Heights Building Restriction Act, 1922,” as amended by the “Shaughnessy Heights Building Restriction Act, 1922, Amendment Act, 1933,” certain conditions, restrictions, and provisions therein set forth were made to apply to the lands described in the said Act as amended: Preamble.

And whereas a petition has been presented by owners of land affected, praying that the aforesaid conditions be made to apply to the said lands for a further period of time and for relief, and that further provisions be made for the enforcement of the provisions thereof:

And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition:

Therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the “Shaughnessy Heights Building Restriction Act, 1922, Amendment Act, 1939.” Short title.

2. Section 2 of the “Shaughnessy Heights Building Restriction Act, 1922,” being chapter 87 of the Statutes of 1922, is amended by striking out the figures “1945” in the second line thereof, and by inserting in lieu thereof the figures “1970.” Amends s. 2.

3. Section 5 of said chapter 87 is amended by inserting after the word “names,” in the fourth line thereof, the words “or Shaughnessy Heights Property Owners’ Association may in its corporate name.” Amends s. 5.
