An Act to amend the "Vancouver Charter."

[Assented to 14th April, 1954.]

Preamble

WHEREAS the City of Vancouver has presented a petition praying that the "Vancouver Charter" be amended:

And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition:

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Vancouver Charter Amendment Act, 1954."

Enacts s. 193A.

2. The "Vancouver Charter," being chapter 55 of the Statutes of 1953, is amended by inserting the following as section 193A:

"193A. The Council may acquire real property for the purpose of providing sites for commercial or industrial development, and for that purpose may:—

"(a) Demolish any building situate thereon:

"(b) Subdivide or resubdivide the said property:

"(c) Provide such services, including roads, water, and sewers, as may be deemed necessary or beneficial:

"(d) Construct such buildings or other improvements on the said property as in the opinion of the Council may be deemed advantageous:

"(e) Hold, lease, sell, or otherwise dispose of any such property."

Amends s. 306.

3. Section 306 is amended by inserting after "purposes," in the second line of clause (s), the words "or where by the nature of its proposed use quantities of articles, materials, or merchandise will be delivered to or taken from such building."

Amends s. 317.

4. Section 317 is amended by adding at the end of clause (cc) the words "and for providing that any other vehicle which comes into the hands of the police shall be held and dealt with in accordance with the provisions of the by-law."

Amends s. 473.

5. Section 473 is amended by striking out the words "a year" in the sixth line of subsection (3), and substituting "nine months."
