

## CHAPTER 57

An Act to Reimburse Cyril Morley Shelford  
for Certain Expenses

[Assented to 1st April, 1966.]

## Preamble.

WHEREAS Cyril Morley Shelford, a member of the Legislative Assembly, has performed, at his own expense and in addition to his usual duties as a member of the Legislative Assembly, an extensive and exceptional public service in attending the hearings of the Royal Commission on Gasoline Price Structure, appointed by Order in Council No. 2653, approved the twenty-first day of October, 1963, and in the preparation and presentation of submissions thereto:

And whereas it is considered that in the special circumstances a payment should be made from public funds of the Province towards the expenses incurred in the performance of that service:

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

## Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Cyril Morley Shelford Reimbursement Act*.

## Minister to make payment from Consolidated Revenue Fund.

2. The Minister of Finance shall pay out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund to Cyril Morley Shelford, M.L.A., towards reimbursement of his expenses incurred in connection with the hearings of the Royal Commission on Gasoline Price Structure the sum of five thousand dollars.

## Eligibility as member.

3. The receipt of the payment made under this Act does not make Cyril Morley Shelford, M.L.A., ineligible as a member of the Legislative Assembly.
