



CHAPTER 85.

An Act to validate certain By-laws of the Municipality of South Vancouver.

[Assented to 10th February, 1927.]

WHEREAS doubts have arisen as to the validity of the debenture by-laws of The Corporation of the District of South Vancouver hereinafter mentioned, for the reason that more than twenty-one days elapsed between the passage by the Council of the said by-laws and the day on which the votes of the electors on said by-laws were taken : Preamble.

And whereas The Corporation of the District of South Vancouver has by its petition prayed that legislation be enacted to validate the said by-laws :

And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition :

Therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the “South Vancouver Debenture By-laws Validation Act.” Short title.

2. “South Vancouver School Extraordinary Loan By-law No. 971, 1926,” being a by-law of The Corporation of the District of South Vancouver to raise by way of loan the sum of twenty-six thousand dollars for the purpose of erecting an annex to the present High School building and purchasing the furniture and equipment therefor, and “South Vancouver School Extraordinary Loan By-law No. 972, 1926,” being a by-law of The Corporation of the District of South Vancouver to raise by way of loan the sum of twenty-nine thousand dollars for the purpose of erecting an addition to the Van Horne School building and purchasing the furniture and equipment therefor, both finally reconsidered, adopted, and passed by the Council Validation of by-laws.

of said municipality on the tenth day of June, 1926, and registered in the office of the County Court for the County of Vancouver on the fourteenth day of June, 1926, shall be deemed to have properly received the assent of the electors of the municipality and to be good and valid by-laws of The Corporation of the District of South Vancouver, and to have taken effect and come into force and been binding on The Corporation of the District of South Vancouver as and from the date of registration thereof.
