



CHAPTER 111.

An Act to amend the "Kimberley
Incorporation Act."

1944, c. 17.

[Assented to 28th April, 1948.]

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia,
enacts as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Kimberley Incorporation Act Amendment Act, 1948." Short title

2. Section 26 of the "Kimberley Incorporation Act," being chapter 17 of the Statutes of 1944, is repealed. Repeals s. 26.

3. (1.) All taxes for the year 1948 imposed under the "Public Schools Act" in the area comprised in the City shall be collected in the manner provided in that Act relating to rural school districts. Provisions relating to taxes

(2.) All taxes imposed under the "Public Schools Act" remaining unpaid at the end of the year 1948 shall be carried forward as delinquent taxes on the rolls of the Provincial Collector and shall be treated for all purposes as delinquent taxes under the "Taxation Act."

(3.) For the year 1949 and thereafter, school taxes shall be levied and collected by The Corporation of the City of Kimberley in accordance with the provisions of the "Municipal Act."

4. Upon this Act coming into force, the Council of Public Instruction may make provision for the inclusion of the City in a school district. Inclusion in a school district
