

## CHAPTER 61.

An Act to Extend the Time for the Expenditure of Ten Per Cent. on the Amount of the Capital of the "South-East Kootenay Railway Company."

[19th February, 1909.]

W HEREAS a petition has been presented by the South-East Preamble. Kootenay Railway Company praying for an Act extending the time for the expending ten per cent, on the amount of the Company's capital as required by sub-section (5) of section 44 of the "British Columbia Railway Act," and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petitioners:

Therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:-

1. Notwithstanding sub-section (5) of section 44 of the "British Extension of time to expend ten per cent. of capital on construction. from the date of the passing of this Act within which to commence construction of the railway and to expend ten per cent. on the amount of its capital on the construction of its line of railway.

2. This Act may be cited as the "South-East Kootenay Railway short title. Act, Amendment Act, 1909."
