



CHAPTER 73.

An Act to amend the “ Anglican Theological College of British Columbia Act, 1915.” 1915, c. 68.

[Assented to 2nd April, 1921.]

WHEREAS a petition has been presented by The Anglican Theological College of British Columbia, praying that the “ Anglican Theological College of British Columbia Act, 1915,” be amended: Preamble.

And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition:

Therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the “ Anglican Theological College of British Columbia Act, 1915, Amendment Act, 1921.” Short title.

2. Subsection (b) of section 6 of the “ Anglican Theological College of British Columbia Act, 1915,” being chapter 68 of the Statutes of 1915, is repealed, and the following is substituted therefor:— Amends subsec. (b) of s. 6.

“(b.) The principal and the warden of the College.”

3. Section 6 of said chapter 68 is amended by adding thereto the following new subsection:— Amends s. 6.

“(d.) Six representatives elected in the first instance by the Council of Latimer Hall, and six representatives elected in the first instance by the Council of St. Mark’s Hall.”

4. Section 6 of said chapter 68 is further amended by striking out of subsection (c) thereof all the words after the word “ determine ” in the second line thereof, and by inserting in lieu thereof, but at the end of the said section, the following words:— Further amends s. 6.

“And one-third of its total membership shall constitute a quorum of the Board.”

Amends s. 7.

5. Section 7 of said chapter 68 is amended by adding at the end thereof the following words:—

“Vacancies in the representation provided for by section 6, subsection (*d*), hereof shall be filled by the remaining members of the respective representation.”

Amends s. 9.

6. Section 9 of said chapter 68 is amended by inserting after the word “College,” in the third line thereof, the words “a vice-chairman who shall also act as vice-president of the College”; and by adding the words “or treasurers” after the word “treasurer” in the third line thereof.

Re-enacts s. 11.

7. Section 11 of said chapter 68 is repealed, and the following is enacted in lieu thereof:—

Duties of Board.

“11. The duties of the Board of Governors shall be in general to represent, control, and manage the affairs of the said College, and in particular to:—

“(a.) Appoint the principal, warden, and teaching staff:

“(b.) Issue all diplomas:

“(c.) Collect, manage, and apply all the funds acquired for general and theological education in the Province, for the endowment of the College, and for the erection and maintenance of its building or for other purposes of the College:

“(d.) Present an annual report to each Diocesan Synod:

“(e.) Prepare a summarized statement to be transmitted to the Provincial Synod of this Province and to the General Synod of Canada.”

Repeals s. 14.

8. Section 14 of said chapter 68 is repealed.

Amends s. 16.

9. Section 16 of said chapter 68 is amended by striking out the words “the president of the College and the secretary of the Board” in the second line thereof, and by inserting the words “the president or vice-president and secretary or a treasurer, or any two of such officers,” in lieu thereof.
