

## CHAPTER 90.

1906, c. 62; 1929, c. 74; 1939, c. 66.

An Act to amend the "Royal Plate Glass Insurance Company of Canada Act, 1906."

[Assented to 30th March, 1950.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS the Royal Plate Glass and General Insurance Company of Canada has presented a petition praying that the "Royal Plate Glass Insurance Company of Canada Act, 1906," be amended so as to change the name of the Company:

And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition:

Therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the "Royal Plate Glass Insurance Company of Canada Act, 1906, Amendment Act, 1950."

Change of name

Saving of rights.

2. The name of the "Royal Plate Glass and General Insurance Company of Canada" is changed to "Royal General Insurance Company of Canada"; but such change of name shall not in any way impair, alter, or affect the rights and liabilities of the Company, and shall not in anywise affect any suit or proceeding now pending, or judgment existing, either by or in favour of or against the Company, which, notwithstanding such change in the name of the Company, may be prosecuted, continued, completed, and enforced as if this Act had not been passed.
