CHAPTER 102

British Columbia School Trustees Association

Incorporation Amendment Act, 1974

[Assented to 20th June, 1974.]

Preamble.

Re-enacts s. 4.

WHEREAS a petition has been presented for the amendment of the British Columbia School Trustees Incorporation Act, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition;

THEREFORE, HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:

- Short Title. 1. This Act may be cited as the British Columbia School Trustees Association Incorporation Act, Amendment Act, 1974.
 - 2. Section 4 of the Act is repealed and the following substituted:

4. The objects of the Association are

- (a) To represent the public interest in public school education;
- (b) To advance the cause of education in the Province and promote public interest in educational affairs;
- (c) To recommend changes in the *Public Schools Act* and any other Act which may affect the public education system;
- (d) To co-operate and provide liaison with Municipal, Provincial and Federal Governments and with organizations in Canada or elsewhere having aims and objects the same as or similar to those of the Association;
- (e) To promote efficiency in the carrying out of the duties and exercise of power by School Boards;
- (f) To promote, conduct and direct research and the gathering of information and to make available the findings,
- (g) To negotiate on behalf of any member Board of School Trustees in its contractual negotiations with teachers or other persons; and
- (h) To take any action, not inconsistent with this Act or any other Act, or any regulations or rules made under the authority of any Act, that the Association deems necessary or advisable to give effect to any policy adopted by it with respect to any question directly or indirectly affecting the purposes and objects of the Association.
