

CHAPTER 92.

An Act to validate certain By-laws of the City of North Vancouver and the Proceedings of the City Council for the Year 1913.

[4th March, 1914.]

WHEREAS there was passed on the twenty-ninth day of October, Preamble. 1912, By-law No. 218 of the City of North Vancouver, called the "North Vancouver City Ward By-law," being a by-law authorizing the division of the City of North Vancouver into wards pursuant to the provisions of the "Municipal Act" and to subsection (f) of section 14, chapter 35, of the "North Vancouver City Incorporation Act, 1906":

And whereas said by-law was not signed, sealed, or registered as required by the provisions of the "Municipal Act":

And whereas, relying on such by-law being in force, the municipal elections for the City of North Vancouver were, in January, 1913, held according to the provisions of the said by-law as if the same had been valid and in force in the said City of North Vancouver:

And whereas it was not until the month of September, 1913, that the said error was discovered, and the said Council resigned on the twenty-seventh day of October, 1913, and a new election was held pursuant to the Statutes:

And whereas doubts have arisen as to the validity of the acts of the Council of the City of North Vancouver from the time of the said election in January, 1913, until its resignation:

And whereas it is advisable that legislative authority should be had validating the acts of the said Council:

And whereas the by-laws set out in the Schedule hereto were duly passed on the dates set out in the said Schedule, but the provisions of the "Municipal Act" were not complied with in respect to one or more of the following requirements, viz.:—

- (a.) Signature of the Mayor:
- (b.) Signature of the City Clerk:
- (c.) Affixing seal of the Corporation:
- (d.) Registration in the office of the Registrar of the County Court for the County of Vancouver:
- (e.) In respect of By-law No. 200, the further defect in addition to (a), (b), (c), and (d) hereof, reconsideration by the Council in accordance with the provisions of section 205 of the "Municipal Act":

And whereas proceedings have been taken under the said by-laws, and it is deemed advisable to validate the same notwithstanding said defects:

And whereas a resolution has been passed by the City Council of the said City of North Vancouver asking for legislation in respect to the foregoing matters:

And whereas By-law No. 101, providing for the indemnity of the Mayor and Alderman for the year 1910, though duly passed by the Council, cannot be found:

Therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

Council and proceedings, 1913, validated.

1. The persons who in the month of January, 1913, were declared elected Mayor and Aldermen of the City of North Vancouver are hereby declared to have been lawfully elected and to have been the lawfully constituted Council of the City of North Vancouver at all times between the sixteenth day of January, 1913, and the twenty-seventh day of October, 1913, and all acts, proceedings, and transactions of said Council during said period are hereby declared to be and to have been at all times valid and effectual, to the like extent as if the said By-law No. 218, called the "North Vancouver City Ward By-law," had been at the date of the passing thereof signed, sealed, and registered in accordance with the provisions of the "Municipal Act."

By-laws in Schedule validated.

- 2. Notwithstanding anything contained in the "Municipal Act" or any amendment thereto or in any other Act, or in any by-law of the Corporation of the City of North Vancouver, the by-laws set out in the Schedule hereto shall not be held to be invalid or set aside or held defective by reason of the fact that the provisions of the "Municipal Act" were not complied with in one or more of the requirements following, viz.:—
 - (a.) Signature by the Mayor:
 - (b.) Signature by the City Clerk:
 - (c.) Affixing the seal of the Corporation:
 - (d.) Registration in the office of the Registrar of the County Court for the County of Vancouver:

(c.) In respect of By-law No. 200, the further defect in addition When such by-laws to (a), (b), (c), and (d) hereof, reconsideration by the effect. Council in accordance with the provisions of section 205 of the "Municipal Act":

And such by-laws, except By-law No. 200, shall respectively be deemed to have taken effect and come into force and be binding on all persons as from the date of the registration thereof, if registered prior to the passing of this Act, or if not registered prior to the passing of this Act, from the date of the reconsideration and final passing thereof by the Council or from any subsequent date fixed therein for the coming into force thereof, to the like extent as if the same had been duly authenticated in respect of the matters above mentioned and registered in accordance with such provisions at the date of such reconsideration and final passing; and By-law No. 200 shall be deemed to have taken effect and come into force and be binding as aforesaid from the date of the passage thereof by the Council to the like extent as if the same had been duly reconsidered and finally passed by the Council in accordance with the provisions of section 205 of the "Municipal Act," and had been duly authenticated in respect of the matters above mentioned and duly registered in accordance with such provisions: Provided always that a copy of each and every of the said by-laws not registered before the passing of this Act shall, upon the passing of this Act, be certified by the City Clerk for the said City of North Vancouver and the seal of the said Corporation affixed thereto and the same forthwith thereafter duly registered.

3. The payment to the Mayor of the City of North Vancouver of Payment to Mayor validated. the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) as indemnity for the year 1910 is hereby validated and confirmed, and the payment by the said city to each of the Aldermen of the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250) as indemnity for the year 1910 is hereby validated and confirmed.

- 4. This Act shall not affect any litigation pending the first day Pending litigation. of February, 1914.
- 5. Whenever the words "Municipal Act" are used in this Act, Interpretation of "Municipal Act." they shall be deemed to refer in the case of each by-law to the "Municipal Act" for the time being in force at the date of the passing thereof as set out in the Schedule hereto.
- 6. This Act may be cited as the "North Vancouver By-laws Vali- Short title. dation Act, 1914."
