



CHAPTER 67.

An Act to amend the “Howe Sound, Pemberton Valley, and Northern Railway Company Act, 1907.” 1907, c. 53

[10th March, 1910.]

WHEREAS a petition has been presented by the Howe Sound, Pemberton Valley, and Northern Railway Company for an Act to amend the “Howe Sound, Pemberton Valley, and Northern Railway Company Act, 1907,” by increasing its capital stock and its bonding powers and by giving to said Company power to connect the terminus of the line at Newport, at the head of Howe Sound, with the City of Vancouver and any intermediate point or points by telegraph or telephone lines, or both, and by extending the northern terminus of the line from Anderson Lake to the town of Lillooet: Preamble

And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition:

Therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

1. Section 1 of chapter 53 of the Statutes of 1907, being “An Act to Incorporate The Howe Sound, Pemberton Valley, and Northern Railway Company,” is hereby amended by striking out in the fifth and sixth lines thereof the following words: “The Howe Sound, Pemberton Valley, and Northern Railway Company,” and to insert in lieu thereof the “Howe Sound and Northern Railway Company.” Amends s. 1.

- Amends s. 3. **2.** Section 3 of the said Act is amended by adding after the word “Lake,” in the eighth line thereof, the words “and from thence to the town of Lillooet.”
- Amends s. 4. **3.** Section 4 of the said Act is hereby amended by striking out the word “one” in the first line thereof and inserting the word “two,” and by striking out the word “fifteen” in the second line thereof and inserting the word “twenty-five.”
- Amends s. 12. **4.** Section 12 of the said Act is amended by striking out the words “twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000)” in the second line thereof and inserting in place thereof the words “thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000).”
- Telegraph and telephone business. **5.** The said Act is further amended by adding the following section: “The Company may construct and operate from the terminus of the line at Newport to the City of Vancouver and connect with any intermediate point or points, telegraph or telephone lines, or both.”
- Amends title. **6.** The title of the “Howe Sound, Pemberton Valley, and Northern Railway Company Act, 1907,” is amended by striking out the words “Pemberton Valley.”
- Amends s. 27. **7.** Section 27 of the said Act is hereby amended by striking out the words “Pemberton Valley” in the first line thereof.
- Short title. **8.** This Act may be cited as the “Howe Sound and Northern Railway Company Act, 1907, Amendment Act, 1910.”
