



CHAPTER 93.

An Act to validate the Articles of Association of Terminal City Club Limited and Amendments thereto.

[Assented to 30th March, 1950.]

Preamble

WHEREAS a doubt has arisen as to the validity of the articles of association of Terminal City Club Limited:

And whereas it is expedient that the said articles of association receive full effect:

Therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the "Terminal City Club Limited Validation Act, 1950."

2. Notwithstanding any law or Statute to the contrary, the said articles of association filed in the office of the Registrar of Companies as of the date of the passing of this Act are hereby declared valid and effectual to all intents and purposes, and to be binding on all persons who are or have been members: Provided that nothing in this Act shall prejudice the said Company's right to amend its articles of association.
