

CHAPTER 60.

An Act to alter the gauge of the Kaslo-Slocan Railway.

[11th April, 1894.]

WHEREAS a petition has been presented by the Kaslo and Slocan Preamble Railway Company, a company duly incorporated by virtue of the "Kaslo-Slocan Railway Act, 1892," praying for power to alter the gauge of the railway to be constructed by the said Company:

And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition:

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

- 1. The Kaslo and Slocan Railway Company may lay out, construct, Gauge. maintain, and operate a railway between the points named in the said Kaslo Slocan Railway Act 1892," of either a standard or narrow gauge, as may be desired by the Company.
- 2. This Act may be cited as the "Kaslo and Slocan Railway Act, Short title. 1894."
