



CHAPTER 77.

An Act to amend the "Vancouver Incorporation Act, 1900."

[Assented to 16th April, 1917.]

WHEREAS a petition has been presented by the City of Vancouver praying that the "Vancouver Incorporation Act, 1900," be amended:

And whereas it is deemed expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition:

Therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

1. Section 214 of the "Vancouver Incorporation Act, 1900" (hereinafter called "the principal Act"), is amended by adding thereto as subsection (1) thereof the following subsection:—

"(1.) In the event of any investigation being held pursuant to this section, or purporting in good faith to be held pursuant thereunder, the Council shall have power to pay all emoluments, fees, and costs, or any honorarium to the Judge, necessarily incurred by the holding of the said investigation, including all or any expenses, costs, fees, emoluments, or any honorarium which have been incurred in or are in any way incidental to any investigation held during the year 1916."

2. This Act may be cited as the "Vancouver Incorporation Act, 1900, Amendment Act, 1917, No. 2."
