



## CHAPTER 61.

1953, c. 49, 1955, c. 100

## An Act to amend the "Kitimat Incorporation Act, 1953."

[Assented to 2nd March, 1956.]

WHEREAS The Corporation of the District of Kitimat was granted additional special borrowing power for the years 1956 and 1957 to keep pace with the demands made upon it caused by the rapid development of the community:

And whereas due to additional projected industrial expansion the special borrowing power will not be adequate:

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Kitimat Incorporation Act, 1953, Amendment Act, 1956."

Amends s. 11.

2. Section 11 of the "Kitimat Incorporation Act, 1953," being chapter 49 of the Statutes of 1953, as amended by section 2 of chapter 100 of the Statutes of 1955, is further amended by striking out the word and figures "and 1957" in the third line of subsection (2), and substituting "to 1961, inclusive."

Further amends s. 11.

3. Section 11 is further amended by striking out the words "the year preceding" in the fifth line of subsection (2).

Letters Patent.

4. The Letters Patent of The Corporation of the District of Kitimat shall be deemed to be amended to give effect to the provisions of the preceding sections.
