



CHAPTER 99.

1941-42, c. 13.

An Act to amend the "City of Greenwood
Debt Refunding Act, 1941-42."*[Assented to 15th March, 1955.]*

Preamble.

WHEREAS clause (d) of subsection (1) of section 16 of the "City of Greenwood Debt Refunding Act, 1941-42," being chapter 13 of the Statutes of 1941-42, provides that until the refunding debentures are fully paid the City shall not pay any salary or remuneration to any member of the Council or of the Board of School Trustees or to any member of the Board of Police Commissioners:

And whereas all refunding payments to date have been regularly made and the City is in sound financial condition:

And whereas it has been found increasingly difficult to attract candidates for election to the Municipal Council due to the financial sacrifice entailed:

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the "City of Greenwood Debt Refunding Act, 1941-42, Amendment Act, 1955."

Amends s. 16.

2. Section 16 of the "City of Greenwood Debt Refunding Act, 1941-42," being chapter 13 of the Statutes of 1941-42, is amended by striking out the words "member of the Council or" in the second line of clause (d) of subsection (1).

Further amends s. 16.

3. Section 16 is further amended by adding the following as clause (e) of subsection (1):—

"(e) Notwithstanding the provisions of this or any other Act, the City may by by-law provide for the payment to each mem-

ber of the Council, including the Mayor, of remuneration up to a maximum of three hundred dollars per annum. The by-law may further provide that a portion of the said remuneration shall be paid as an allowance for expenses incident to the discharge of the duties of office."
