



## CHAPTER 50.

An Act to Enable the Coldstream Estate Company, Limited, and the White Valley Irrigation and Power Company, Limited, to amalgamate their water rights.

[12th March, 1909.]

**W**HEREAS the Coldstream Estate Company, Limited, and the Preamble.  
White Valley Irrigation and Power Company, Limited, have presented a petition praying for the passing of a Bill enabling the said Companies to amalgamate their water and other rights, powers and privileges relating to water and its use, and to hold them for their common benefit:

And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition:

Now therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

1. It shall be lawful for the said Coldstream Estate Company, Limited, and the White Valley Irrigation and Power Company, Limited, and they and each of them are hereby authorised and empowered to: Powers of the Companies.

(a.) Amalgamate all records of water and all rights to use water and all other rights, powers and privileges relating to water and its use: Amalgamation records and rights.

Provided, however, that nothing in this Act contained shall Proviso.  
be construed to authorise the use for power purposes of water recorded for agricultural or domestic purposes:

- Mingle waters. (b.) Mingle the waters held by each Company for their separate or common benefit as they may deem expedient:
- Distribution. (c.) Arrange for the distribution of the waters now held by each Company for their separate or common benefit:
- The work in common. (d.) Use the canals, ditches, and other works of each Company, either for their separate or common benefit:
- General. (e.) And generally to hold, enjoy, control, distribute and manage the water and water rights and other property used in connection with the water-works system of each Company now held in severalty for their general or common benefit.
- Further joint powers. **2.** It shall be lawful for the said Companies to jointly acquire other water rights according to law.
- To make contracts. **3.** The said Companies, and each of them, are hereby further authorised and empowered to enter into any arrangement and make such contracts and agreements that they may agree upon in respect of the matters aforesaid, or any of them.
