

CHAPTER 68.

An Act to provide for the Payment of a Grant to Margaret Copeland Gibbs.

[Assented to 18th March, 1960.]

WHEREAS the late Philip Archibald Gibbs did not attend the current session of the Legislative Assembly:

And whereas, at the date of his death on the fourth day of March, 1960, Philip Archibald Gibbs was a member of the Legislative Assembly, and it is fitting that the Legislature and the people of British Columbia acknowledge his public service by making the grant hereinafter provided:

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:----

Short title.

Preamble.

1. This Act may be cited as the Margaret Copeland Gibbs Act.

Payment of grant from Consolidated Revenue Fund.

2. There shall be paid to Margaret Copeland Gibbs, out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of five thousand dollars.
