

## CHAPTER 64.

R.S.B.C 1948, c. 353. 1950, c. 77.

## An Act to amend the "British Columbia University Act."

[Assented to 14th April, 1954.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the "Pritish Columbia University Act Amendment Act, 1954."

Re enacts s 5

- 2. Section 5 of the "British Columbia University Act," being chapter 353 of the "Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1948," is repealed, and the following is substituted:—
- "5. The University shall have power to invest for the benefit of the University all or any sums of money belonging to it and available for investment in any of the following securities: The bonds, stocks, debentures, or securities of Canada or of any Province thereof, or securities the principal and interest of which are guaranteed by the Government of Canada or any Province thereof; the debentures of any municipality in the Province; or first mortgages of any freehold property in the Province, or the purchase of rental-bearing real estate therein."

Re enacts s. 66

- 3. Section 66 is repealed, and the following is substituted:—
- "66. At least fourteen weeks prior to the date fixed for the election of the Chancellor and members of the Senate respectively, the Registrar shall send to each member of the Convocation whose address is known a notice that the election register has been prepared and is under the custody and control of the Registrar and is open to inspection at all reasonable hours by all members entitled to vote."
