



CHAPTER 67.

An Act to Amend the “Westminster and Vancouver Short Line Railway Act.”

[23rd April, 1892.]

WHEREAS the New Westminster and Vancouver Short Line Railway Company have presented a petition, praying for an Act to amend their Act of Incorporation, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition :

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows :—

1 Section 11 of the said Act is hereby repealed.

Repeals s 11.

2. The actual work of construction of the railway, authorized by the said Act and this Act to be constructed, shall be commenced within two years, and shall be completed within three years from the passing of this Act.

Commencement and completion of railway.

3. Sections 17, 18, 19, 20, and 21 of the said Act, are hereby repealed.

Repeals ss 17, 18, 19, 20, and 21.

4 All the rights, powers, and privileges conferred and all the duties and obligations imposed by the British Columbia Railway Act, except the right to work the road by the force and power of electricity or by any motive power other than steam, are hereby conferred and imposed upon the New Westminster and Vancouver Short Line Railway Company as if the said Company had been incorporated subsequent to the coming into force of the said British Columbia Railway Act.

Certain rights conferred and all duties imposed by 1890, c. 39, conferred and imposed on Company.

5. This Act may be cited as the “New Westminster and Vancouver Short title. Short Line Railway Act Amendment Act, 1892.”
