

## CHAPTER 104.

## An Act to amend the Royal Inland Hospital Act, 1896.

[Assented to 20th March, 1959.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Royal Inland Hospital Act, 1896,

**2**. Section 3 of the *Royal Inland Hospital Act*, 1896, as re-enacted by chapter 59 of the Statutes of 1926–27, is repealed and the following is substituted:—

"3. (1) The property and affairs of the Royal Inland Hospital shall be managed by a Board of Directors in which shall be vested full control of the revenue and expenditure of the hospital.

"(2) Except as provided herein, the Board of Directors shall consist of thirteen persons, ten of whom shall be elected as hereinafter provided, two of whom shall be appointed from time to time by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, and one of whom shall be appointed annually by the Municipal Council of the City of Kamloops.

"(3) The membership of the Board of Directors may be increased to fourteen persons, by resolution of the said Board authorizing the appointment annually of a director to represent any hospital improvement district that becomes established in the vicinity of the City of Kamloops or in the territory tributary thereto.

"(4) Five directors shall form a quorum of the Board of Directors for the doing of any act or performing or transacting any business which may, under the provisions of this Act, or the by-laws, rules, and regulations of the body corporate, be done, performed, or transacted."

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
