# An Act to amend the "Shaughnessy Heights Building Restriction Act, 1922."

#### [Assented to 30th March, 1950.]

Preamble

WHEREAS by the "Shaughnessy Heights Building Restriction Act, 1922," certain conditions and restrictions in the said Act set forth were made to apply to the lands in the said Act described:

And whereas Fairview Baptist Church is the registered owner of Amended Lot 3 and Lots 4 and 5, Block 488, District Lot 526, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 4502, which are part of the lands hereinbefore referred to:

And whereas it is deemed expedient and in the best interest of all concerned that the said Amended Lot 3 and Lots 4 2nd 5, Block 488, District Lot 526, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 4502, be freed from the aforesaid conditions and restrictions:

Therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

Short title.

Amends a. 4.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Shaughnessy Heights Building Restriction Act, 1922, Amendment Act, 1950."

2. Section 4 of the "Shaughnessy Heights Building Restriction Act, 1922," being chapter 87 of the Statutes of 1922, is amended by adding after "Block 4," in the second last line of the amendment enacted by chapter 78 of the Statutes of 1933, the words "Amended Lot 3 and Lots 4 and 5, Block 488, District Lot 526, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 4502."
