**An Act to Amend the District of Surrey
Hospital Grant Enabling Act**

[Assented to 20th March, 1964.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *District of Surrey Hospital Grant Enabling Act Amendment Act, 1964*.

Amends
preamble.

2. The preamble to the *District of Surrey Hospital Grant Enabling Act*, being chapter 61 of the Statutes of 1954, is amended by striking out the words "within the municipal limits of" in the fourth line of the first paragraph and substituting the words "to serve a portion of", so that the first paragraph shall read as follows:—

"Whereas the White Rock Hospital Society, a society incorporated under the *Societies Act* of the Province of British Columbia (hereinafter called the 'Society'), has constructed a hospital in the White Rock area to serve a portion of The Corporation of the District of Surrey (hereinafter called the 'Municipality'):"

Amends s. 2.

3. Section 2 is amended by inserting after the word "by" in the second line the words "the hospital aforesaid or by" and by striking out the words "a hospital established within the defined area for the special benefit of which the facilities of that hospital have been so declared" in the seventh, eighth, and ninth lines and substituting the words "the hospital mentioned in the by-law", so that the section shall read as follows:—

"2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Surrey may by by-law declare that the facilities provided by the hospital aforesaid or by any hospital established within the Municipality are for the special benefit of some portion or portions of the Municipality, and may define the portion or portions of the Municipality that will be benefited. Any such by-law may authorize the issue and sale of debentures in serial form, and may provide that the proceeds of the debentures shall be used as a grant in aid of the hospital mentioned in the by-law."

Date of effect.

4. This Act shall be deemed to have come into force and effect on the fifteenth day of April, 1957, and is retroactive to the extent necessary to give full force and effect to the provisions thereof on and after that date.
