

CHAPTER 73.

An Act to amend the "Vancouver and Lulu Island 1891, c. 60. Railway Act, 1891."

[8th May, 1897.]

WHEREAS a petition has been presented praying for an Act Preamble. extending the time for commencement and completion of the works contemplated by the "Vancouver and Lulu Island Railway Act, 1891," and confirming and ratifying to the petitioners the powers of the Company:

And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of such petition:

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

1. Section 19 of the said Act is hereby repealed.

Repeals, s. 19.

2. The railway authorised to be constructed by the said Act shall When to be combe completed within three years after the passing of this Act.

When to be completed.

- 3. All the powers, rights and privileges conferred upon "The Van-Declaration, privicouver and Lulu Island Railway Company" by the "Vancouver and leges. Lulu Island Railway Act, 1891," are hereby declared to be and to have been lawfully exercisable by the said Company, which is hereby declared to be and to have been, since the 20th day of April, 1891, a body corporate and politic under the name of "The Vancouver and Lulu Island Railway Company," with all the rights, powers and privileges conferred upon the said Company under the said "Vancouver and Lulu Island Railway Act, 1891."
- 4. No Act of this Legislature requiring the Company in case Wires under ground. efficient means are devised for carrying telegraph, telephone or electric

wires under ground, to adopt such means, and abrogating the right given by this Act to continue carrying lines on poles through cities, towns or incorporated villages, shall be deemed an infringement of the privileges granted by this Act.

Short title

5. This Act may be cited as the "Vancouver and Lulu Island Railway Act (1891) Amendment Act, 1897."
