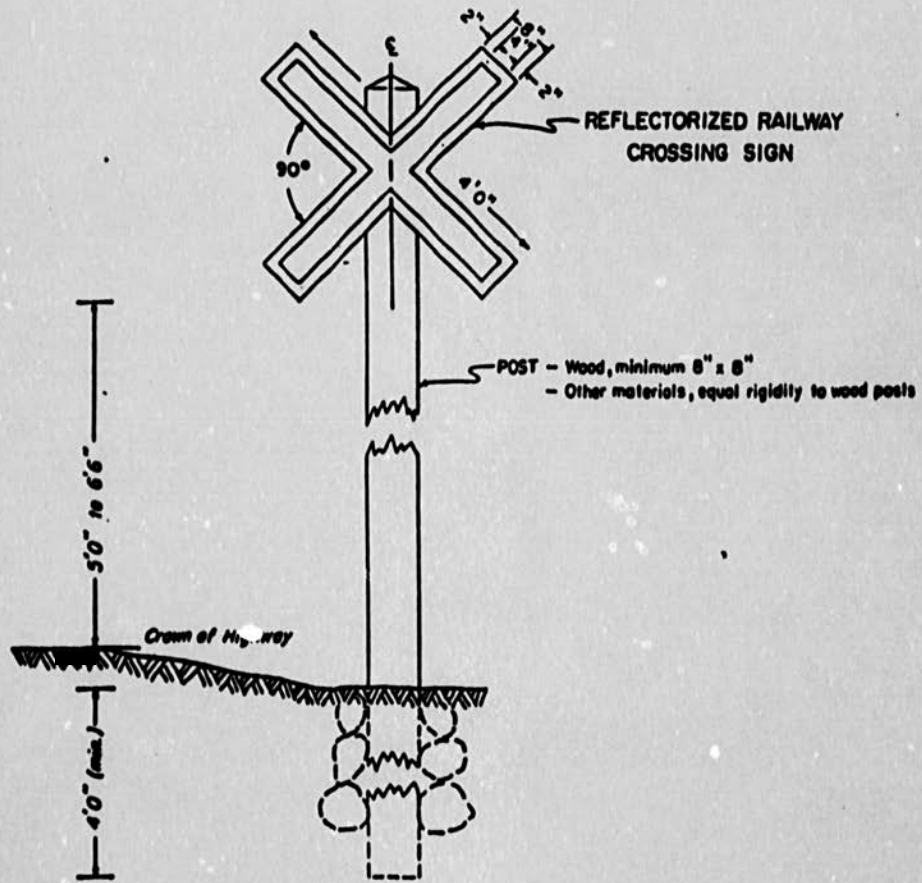

SCHEDULE

- 1. Section 23 (1) is amended**
 - (a) by striking out the concluding sentence in paragraph (a) and substituting "Signs shall be placed so that each line of highway traffic is faced by a sign at right angles to the centre line of the highway.", and**
 - (b) by adding the following paragraph:**
 - (c) Where a crossing sign is installed, relocated or reconditioned on or after August 1, 1988, this shall be done in a manner that conforms with Appendix B and, where automatic signals are used, with Appendices B, G, H and I.**
- 2. Section 23 (2) is repealed and the following substituted:**
 - (2) The sign shall be placed on a post of 8 by 8 inch sound timber or of other material of equal rigidity and shall be set firmly in the ground.**
- 3. Appendix B is repealed and the Appendix B attached to this Schedule is substituted.**
