Schedule

- 1 Section 1 of B.C. Reg. 301/90, the Environmental Data Quality Assurance Regulation, is amended
 - (a) by adding the following definition:
 - "CAEAL" means the Canadian Association for Environmental Analytical Laboratories;,
 - (b) in the definition of "designated characteristics" by striking out "the ministry" and substituting "CAEAL",
 - (c) in the definition of "Inter-laboratory Comparison Program" by striking out "the Ministry of Environment, Lands and Parks" and substituting "CAEAL", and by striking out "the ministry" and substituting "CAEAL", and
 - (d) in the definition of "registered laboratory" by striking out "the director" and substituting "CAEAL".
- 2 Sections 5 and 6 are repealed and the following substituted:

Inter-laboratory Comparison Program

- 5 To become and remain registered under the Inter-laboratory Comparison Program a laboratory must
 - (a) be registered with CAEAL,
 - (b) analyze each reference sample supplied by CAEAL for each designated characteristic for which the laboratory seeks to be certified,
 - (c) provide the analytical results to CAEAL in the manner specified by CAEAL, and
 - (d) provide the ministry with a certified copy of the CAEAL certification letter for each designated characteristic and the results of each inter-laboratory test result within 30 days after the results are mailed by CAEAL.
