ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF FORESTS, LANDS, NATURAL RESOURCE  
OPERATIONS AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT

Ministerial Order No. M 255

Pursuant to section 128(2) of the *Forest Act*, the type of wood residue described in the application received from Zellstoff Celgar Limited Partnership dated May 16, 2018 is considered surplus to the requirements of timber processing facilities in British Columbia and is exempt from the requirements of section 127 of the *Forest Act* on the following conditions:

1. This exemption of wood residue is for 15,000 bone dry units of hog fuel originating from the applicants supplier timber processing facilities in the Castlegar, British Columbia area.
2. Before any wood residue exempted under this order is exported, an export permit for the wood residue must be obtained from the Ministry of Forests, Lands, Natural Resource Operations and Rural Development.
3. This exemption is not transferable.
4. This exemption and any export permit under this exemption are subject to termination for non-compliance with any of the above conditions.
5. Unless terminated earlier, this exemption expires June 22, 2019.
