#### **SCHEDULE**

1 The Agricultural Land Reserve Use Regulation, B.C. Reg. 30/2019, is amended by adding the following section:

#### Temporary exception for wine made from grapes

- **13.01** (1) In this section:
  - **"primary farm product rule"** means a requirement respecting the proportion of primary farm product used to make an alcohol product imposed under
    - (a) section 13 (2) of this regulation, or
    - (b) section 2 (2) (b) of the Agricultural Land Reserve Use, Subdivision and Procedure Regulation as it read on June 14, 2015;

## "temporary exception period" means the period that

- (a) begins on the date on which this section comes into force, and
- (b) ends on March 31, 2025.
- (2) Despite section 13, primary farm product rules do not apply with respect to either of the following:
  - (a) the processing by a winery of wine made from grapes or grape products acquired by the winery during the temporary exception period, if processing begins during that period;
  - (b) the continued processing, and the storage and sale, of wine to which paragraph (a) applies.
