# INFORMATION BULLETIN

### To All Authorized Inspectors and Inspection Facilities

#### **Re: Semi-Annual Inspections and 2020 Certificate of Approval decals stock issue**

CVSE has been notified by Queens Printer that decal stock with a 2020 expiry has been depleted.

This means Authorized Inspectors will be required to amend the current procedure of cutting decals for semi-annual inspections until June 30, 2020. This **ONLY** impacts semi-annual inspections.

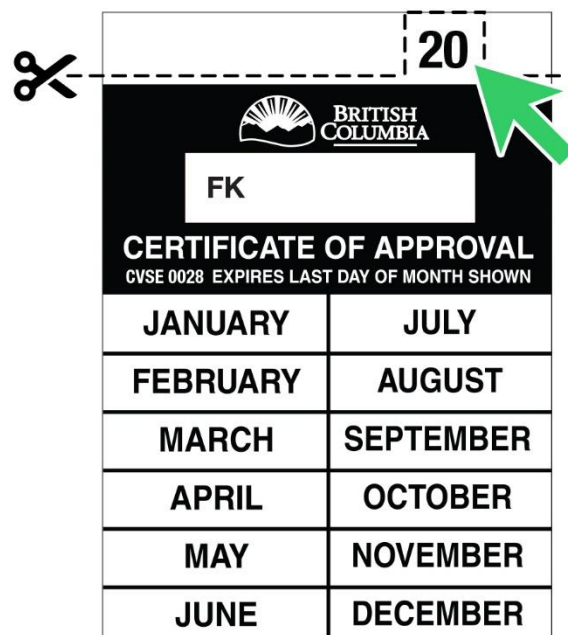
Where possible, facilities are urged to manage their current decal stock bearing the 2020 calendar year for semi-annual inspections and to purchase additional stock for annual inspections if applicable.

Facilities that conduct semi-annual inspections, but do not have decal stock on hand showing the 2020 calendar year, must follow the decal cutting directions below:

1. This applies to Certificate of Approval decal stock displaying '2021/2022/2023' expiry dates
2. As seen below, semi-annual inspections will require the decal to be cut showing the year "20" rather than "2020".

When using the amended decal cutting procedure, inspection facilities must provide a comment on the inspection report referencing VI Bulletin no. 01-20, so the customer can avoid delays or further questioning by enforcement staff at the roadside.
