Re: Inspection Intervals for Commercial Trailers

Division 25.14 (3)(c) of the *Motor Vehicle Act & Regulations* states that ... “commercial trailers, except a commercial trailer used with a logging truck or equipped with a dump box, will require annual inspection...” Dump trailers and logging trailers will continue to be inspected semi-annually.

Dump trailer and logging trailer are defined as follows:

- **Dump Trailer** – a dump box designed to disgorge its load out of the top, bottom, front, side or back from the axles it rides on or by being moved to another piece of equipment (IE: Transfer Trailer).
- **Logging Trailer** – any trailer capable of hauling logs that is attached to a vehicle registered as a logging truck or a trailer designed or modified to transport logs (IE: Flat Deck Trailer with stakes).
