## Re: New Online Vehicle Inspection Program System

As previously announced in INFORMATION BULLETIN #01- 12, a new Vehicle Inspection Program (VIP) online system will be implemented effective April 2013. This web based system is expected to provide a more secure, streamlined and simplified experience for inspection program users. This system can be accessed via any internet device.

These system enhancements will provide facilities multiple benefits such as:

- On-line application for new facilities;
- On-line licence renewal for established facilities using their Business BCeID;
- On-line direct payment for licencing through BC Express Pay;

Authorized Inspectors will benefit from features such as:

- Easy and secure access to search, review and verify inspections submitted with their certification number using personal BCeID ;
- System security measures to ensure system integrity and proper usage of inspectors' authorization;
- On-line renewal of certification using personal BCeID;
- On-line direct payment for certifcations through BC Express Pay;

All system users will benefit from:

- Time savings for administrative program submissions and program renewals;
- Cost savings minimal requirements to mail or ship documents;
- Improved 2-way communication between VIP program and users via email;
- All program information such as Notices & Bulletins will be distributed via email in addition to website posting at www.cvse.ca;
- All required forms and documents such as business licenses and garage policies can be scanned electronically and submitted via email; and
- Authorized Inspectors certifications sent electronically via email.

To create your BCeID please go to www.bceid.ca and follow the links below.

- Click on the 'Register' button at bottom right.
- Click 'Register for a Personal BCeID' button on the right.
- Follow the online instructions for registering for a Personal BCeID.

After online registration is complete, you must present your identity documents in person at a Point of Service location within 60 days to verify your identity and finish registration. The two pieces of identification selected during your online registration process must be presented to the authorized BCeID Point of Service agent when verifying the BCeID application. To find the closest Point of Service location, click on the 'Point of Service Location' link on the left or at bottom of the BCeID web pages.

Once you have registered your Personal BCeID, please remember to retain your password and security questions for future reference.

## It is of utmost importance that all authorized inspectors register and obtain their personal BCeID prior to implementation of the new VIP Online.
