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**BACKGROUND**

British Columbia was asked to consider the movement of 6.1 metres (20ft) wide manufactured homes into the Fort Nelson area to provide economical housing.

**PURPOSE OF CIRCULAR**

A route evaluation was conducted and the approval is now in place for industry to transport these modular buildings/manufactured homes into the Peace River Area – see revised T-69B for more details.
