SUBJECT: Travel Times Pilot for Loads 3.21 m to 4.4 m Overall Width March 19, 2012 to March 18, 2013

PURPOSE OF CIRCULAR

To announce that for a period of one year, from March 19, 2012 to March 18, 2013 inclusive, the travel times for permits for loads from 3.21 m wide to 4.4 m wide on roads under the jurisdiction of the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure, will change to the times shown below, as a pilot project.

Feedback to the pilot project will be reviewed quarterly, and should be directed to <u>Commercial.Transport@gov.bc.ca</u>

BACKGROUND

In general, the pilot travel times introduce restrictions on Friday evenings for loads from 3.21 m to 3.8 m wide, but open up additional travel times on the weekends for loads 3.21 to 4.4 m wide, and increase uniformity for travel times under permit across BC. In the Peace Region, there are no changes to present allowances under the pilot project.

TRAVEL TIMES

For loads from **3.21 to 3.8 m** Overall Width:

Travel at any time on any day, except:

- No travel on Fridays and Saturdays from 15:30 until 04:00 the next day (except in the Peace Region), and
- In the Lower Mainland, west of Abbotsford (Hwy 11) and south of Squamish, no travel on weekdays from 07:00 to 09:00 or from 15:30 to 18:00, except between Abbotsford and 104 Street on Highway 1, and
- No travel during General Holiday restrictions, described at Section 3.8.7 of the Commercial Transport Procedures Manual (CTPM) at www.cvse.ca (except in the Peace Region)

For loads from **3.81 to 4.4 m** Overall Width:

 Travel Times Pilot (March 19/12 to March 18/13): Travel at any time on any day, except: No travel on Fridays and Saturdays from 15:30 until 04:00 the next day, or on Sundays from 15:30 to 24:00 (except in the Peace Region), and In the Peace Region, no travel in darkness on Friday evening/Saturday morning, or Saturday evening/Sunday morning, or Sunday evening until 24:00, and In the Lower Mainland, west of Abbotsford (Hwy 11) and south of Squamish, no travel on wookdays from 07:00 to 09:00 or from 15:30 to 18:00, except between
 travel on weekdays from 07:00 to 09:00 or from 15:30 to 18:00, except between Abbotsford and 104 Street on Highway 1, and In the Southern Interior, on Highway 1 between Hope and Cache Creek, no travel during the hours of darkness, and In the Kootenays:
 No travel on Highway 93 east of Radium from the last Friday in June to September 15, except between 03:00 and 06:00 No travel on No. 1 Mine Road (off of Hwy 43) from Elkford to Fording River Operations between 06:00 and 08:00 and between 18:00 and 20:00
 No travel during General Holiday restrictions, described at Section 3.8.7 of the Commercial Transport Procedures Manual (CTPM) at www.cvse.ca (except in the Peace Region)

Additional Regional Travel Restrictions > 3.8 m Wide

- 1. In the Southern Interior, on Highway 1 between Hope and Cache Creek, no travel during the hours of darkness
- 2. In the Kootenays:
 - No travel on Highway 93 east of Radium from the last Friday in June to September 15, except between 03:00 and 06:00
 - No travel on No. 1 Mine Road (off of Hwy 43) from Elkford to Fording River Operations between 06:00 and 08:00 and between 18:00 and 20:00





Additional Regional Travel Restrictions > 3.8 m Wide

No travel on Hwy 97 from the jct with Hwy 77 to the Yukon Border, during the hours of darkness and/or over 36 m OAL

Note: In the Peace Region, pilot travel times (shown here) are the same as pre-pilot travel times.

3.8.7 General Holidays

Where a permit or T-Form restricts travel on General Holidays, no travel is permitted from 14:00 (2:00 pm) on the day preceding the holiday to 24:00 (Midnight) on the day of the holiday, or as specified by CVSE. If the General Holiday falls on Saturday or Sunday, the additional designated day of observance (e.g. Friday or Monday) may also be considered a General Holiday. Holiday travel restrictions have been set through to the end of 2012, as follows:
