NOTICE

To All National Safety Code Safety Certificate Holders

To Whom It May Concern:

This notice is to advise and notify all National Safety Code (NSC) Safety Certificate holders in British Columbia of the Commercial Vehicle Safety and Enforcement Branch's intent to cancel NSC Safety Certificates that have been inactive for 5 or more years.

NSC Safety Certificates that have not had a commercial vehicle licensed and/or operating under its NSC number since September 2006 will be cancelled.

The *Motor Vehicle Act* and *Motor Vehicle Act Regulations* have been amended several times since 2007 to reflect changes to National Safety Code standards and requirements. Section 37.04(c.1) of the *Motor Vehicle Act Regulations* requires certificate holders to provide satisfactory evidence as to the establishment of and the ability to maintain practices and procedures necessary to ensure compliance with the Act and Regulations.

NSC Certificate holders that have been inactive for 5 years or more must notify the National Safety Code program office, in writing by January 31, 2012, as to why the cancellation should not take place and indicate when their Safety Certificate will become active.
